



ARTICLE 1: DEFINITIONS

1.1. In these general terms and conditions, the following definitions apply:

1. Event: the sporting event organized by the organization (Footvolley Groningen) in any year: International Footvolley Tournament Groningen also known as IFTG.
 2. Participant: the natural person who is on a by the organizer admitted way has registered for participation in the event.
 3. Agreement: the agreement for participation of the participant in the event.
 4. Organizer: the legal entity (in this IFTG) with which the participant has entered into an agreement.
- 1.2. These general conditions apply to each agreement.

ARTICLE 2: PARTICIPATION

2.1. The participant must have reached the minimum age of 18 on the day on which the event takes place. There is no maximum age associated with individual participation.

2.2. The participant may participate in the event at the invitation of the organization. If he / she has fully and truthfully completed the registration form to that effect, or has confirmed his or her participation to IFTG by e-mail and if the participant has agreed to the general terms and conditions.

2.3. the organizer of the event is entitled at all times to change the playing times of the teams.

2.4. Refund of registration fees is not possible. If unable to attend, the participant can be replaced free of charge. This must be contacted by the organizer of the event no later than 21 December.

2.5. The organizer of the event may decide to cancel the event due to exceptional circumstances (force majeure).

2.6. Due to the organizer's decision not to proceed with the event, there is no liability for reimbursement of the costs the participant incurred costs in relation to the event.



ARTICLE 3: LIABILITY

3.1. Participation is at your own risk. The organizer is not liable for any damage, however named, that the participant may suffer as a result of the participation. The organizer is also not liable for loss, theft or damage of property. Unless this damage is the direct result of intent or gross negligence attributable to the organizer. This exclusion of liability also applies to serious damages such as all possible types of damage as a result of injury or death.

3.2. If, in spite of the provisions of the first paragraph of this article, liability of the organizer for damage of the participant has to be assumed, the organizer's obligation to compensate that damage is limited to not more than the amount that the organizer of the organizer has to pay in respect of that pays out damage.

3.3. The participant must be adequately insured against the risk of damage that he or a survivor may suffer as a result of his death, injury or illness caused by his participation in the event.

3.4. The participant declares to be familiar with the fact that participation requires good health in both a psychological and physical sense, and declares that he meets this requirement and that he has adequately prepared himself for the event through training and otherwise.

3.5. The participant indemnifies the organizer for liability for damage that third parties may suffer as a result of an act or omission attributable to a participant in relation to the event. The participant must be adequately insured against the risk of liability for the said damage.

3.6. The participant indemnifies the organizer for liability for damage that a third party may suffer due to the participant during his participation in the event, unless this damage is the direct result of intent or gross negligence attributable to the organizer.



ARTICLE 4: PORTRAIT LAW

4.1. The participant grants prior permission to the organizer for the disclosure of photographs and images and the like, made during or around the event, on which the participant is visible.

ARTICLE 5: PERSONAL DATA

5.1. The personal data provided by a Participant are recorded by the Organizer in accordance with the General Data Protection Act (AVG) Act. The same privacy legislation applies throughout the European Union (EU). By participating in an Event, a Participant grants permission to the Organizer to use the personal data for the transmission of information to the Participant and (if the Participant has given permission for this on the registration form) for providing the personal data to third parties for the purpose of sending information to the Participant.
